- b. Must have fulfilled an approved Internship.

2. Certificated Members (CeM)

- a. Members that, not being part of 1 above.
- b. Must be in possession of at least a 360 credit Bachelor Degree or Diploma or an equivalent degree from a University, with a major in Statistical Sciences. The minimum requirement would be SAQA approved NQF level 6; hence the Degree should be on SAQA approved NQF Level 7 and Diploma on SAQA approved NQF Level 6.
- c. Must have fulfilled an approved Internship.

3. Associated Members (AsM)

- a. Members having fulfilled a partial requirement mentioned in 1 and 2 above.
